


## **ELK HUNTING UNIT 6 BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION**

Including portions of Magoffin, Johnson, Floyd, Martin, and Pike counties, the western boundary of unit 6 follows highway 7 north from the intersection of highway 80 to the Bert T Combs Mountain Parkway/highway 9009; west along the Mountain Parkway to the Magoffin county line; northeast along the Magoffin county line to the Johnson county line; east along the Johnson county line and then along the Martin county line to the Kentucky-West Virginia border; south along the Kentucky-West Virginia border to highway 119; south along highway 119 to the intersection of highway 23; north on highway 23 to the intersection of highway 80; south on highway 80 to the intersection of highway 7 to complete the unit 6 boundary.
